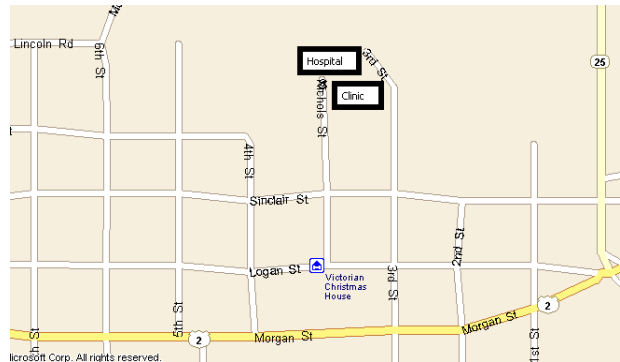

Not only does Dr. Huntwork specialize in traditional abdominal surgery, but most pelvic procedures can be performed on an outpatient basis using a Laparoscope. Laparoscopic surgery is minimally invasive. A tiny telescope is placed through a small hole under the belly button. Dr. Huntwork, using a tiny camera and TV screen, guides the instruments through two other small holes and the procedure is performed with little cutting.



Advantages of Laparoscopy include major surgery without a large incision, less pain after surgery, shorter hospital stay and returning to work and normal activity sooner. We currently offer...
